Ancient Green Tea

Ancient green tea can only be made for a brief time twice a year during the early spring and beginning of winter when the cool mists and clouds rest on the high mountain peaks of Jing Mai's 1300 year old ancient tea forest. The flavor and aroma are well balanced and refreshing with notes of melon, flowers and toasted nut. The finish is sweet, smooth and slightly more pungent than green teas from Eastern China due to the rare tea tree varieties used to make this tea.

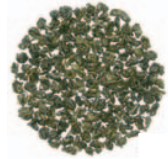


High Mountain Green and Oolong Teas

Pearl Jasmine Green Tea - One of our favorites, this green tea is infused with fresh jasmine blossoms by a traditional tea scenting process – a technique that dates back over 9 centuries. The resulting taste is floral, sweet, and refreshing with the highly aromatic flavor of jasmine.



Osthmanthus Green Tea - In China, Osthmanthus flowers are used to make golden colored wines, cakes and sweet smelling perfumes. These tiny little yellow and orange blossoms are delightful to the senses. The combination of the flower's sweet and fruity taste and the clean and aromatic flavor of green tea makes the osthmanthus tea one of the Middle Kingdom's favorite.. A must try. This tea is also good to drink cold.



Oolong Tea - Oolong, some say, is the most complex of all teas because the flavor balances between green and black tea. The taste is best described as a flowery sweet aroma combined with a pleasant aftertaste. It is also great cold – with no ice.



White Tea - The white tea bushes of Northern Fujian were domesticated from wild tea trees and exhibit silvery down-covered leaves that have been prized for their medicinal properties for more than 1000 years. Silver Needle has a clear, light golden infusion with a rich flavored body, unique savory aroma and sweet mellow finish.
